

How to use the Evangelistic Block Party Trailer

Selecting a site

To set up the jump house you will need a perfectly level area that measures at least 20X20'. As children play in it, the jump house will gradually slide down hill. It is important that the jump house be tied down so it will not move.

Man power

Users will need at least one person to man the jump house and each of the concession stations.

When everything is in use, users will need to have a minimum of 4 people manning the equipment.

Electrical Power

All of the equipment requires electrical power. It is recommended that each piece of equipment be run on its own 20 amp circuit.

Users will need to provide their own extension cords.

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Purpose of the Evangelistic Block Party Trailer

The block party trailer was built for the local church and other Southern Baptist entities to do evangelistic events.

Only people can do evangelism; but the block party trailer is a tool for them to reach their community for Christ.

The trailer is not released for birthdays, anniversaries or other personal events. It is set aside for evangelism.

Contents of the Block Party Trailer

The trailer contains commercial quality equipment.

- 1 BBQ Grill
- 1 15X15' Bounce House
- 1 Cotton Candy Machine
- 1 Snow Cone Machine
- 1 Pop Corn Machine

The trailer does not contain any of the supplies. The local user is responsible for procuring their own supplies.

In Albuquerque we purchase our supplies and equipment from B and H Wholesale at (505) 242-2611

Requirements for use of the Block Party Trailer

First - Training

Block Party Training - CBA has a training presentation on block parties. This training covers what a block party is, what it does for the local church and how to do it.

Block Party Trailer Training - Every piece of equipment on the trailer requires training in how to use it.

Second - Fees

Use Fee — Fees are subject to change but currently the use fee is \$100 for CBA churches. Whether the trailer is used for one hour or for a whole day it is still \$100 use fee.

Damages — If any of the equipment is damaged, please let us know upon return, so it can be repaired.

Third - Transportation

The user is responsible for transporting the trailer to and from their event. Although a 1/2 ton vehicle will pull it, a 3/4 ton or larger is better. The trailer is equipped with brakes, so the towing vehicle must be equipped with a round 7 point plug.

The user is responsible for providing their own receiver hitch with a 2 5/16" ball.



Reserving the Block Party Trailer

The block party trailer is in great demand so it is wise to make reservations for it as soon as possible. Weekends, holidays and summer time are usually booked well in advance.
